827.072 HB 1159 July 1, 2026	Adds offense of transmission of generated CSAM; F2
828.126 HB 1159 July 1, 2026	Reorganizes offenses related to sexual activities involving animals; reclassifies certain offenses to F2s
847.011(5) HB 1159 July 1, 2026	Reclassifies possession of child-like sex doll to F3

907.041(5)(a)(26) HB 445 July 1, 2026 “Missy’s Law”	Adds offenses under 847.0135 to list of Dangerous Crimes for pretrial detention (and mandatory remand). (computer pornography, traveling to meet a minor)
775.215(4) SB 212 July 1, 2026	Adds “public swimming pool” to list of places certain sex offenders cannot live within 1000ft of. Applies to those whose qualifying SO offense committed after 7/1/26 AS WELL AS those who qualified for the previous restrictions and change permanent residence after 7/1.
948.30(6) and (7) SB 212 July 1, 2026	Mandatory SOP conditions for certain sex offenders, offense date after July 1, 2026 Prohibition on living within 1000ft of public pool; no working or volunteering at public pool; no visiting public pool without prior approval from PO.

Creates exception to the new min mans in certain circumstances (similar to a Romeo and Juliet out) for over 14, permission by child, no more than 4 year age difference, no sharing with third party.
